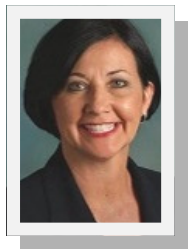
LEADERship Program - Cindy LaConte

We are now taking applications for Class 30! Please email me if you would like me to send information to someone. Thank You again for your on-going support!!!!!!



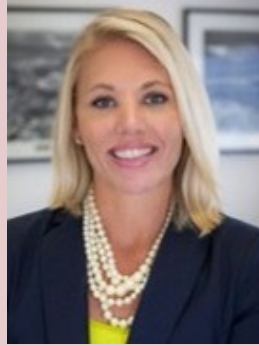
Women of Distinction LEADERship Nominees

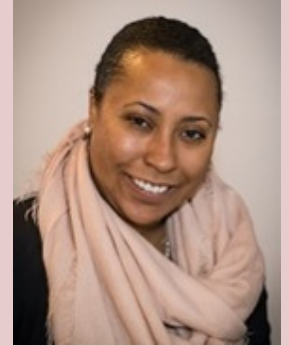

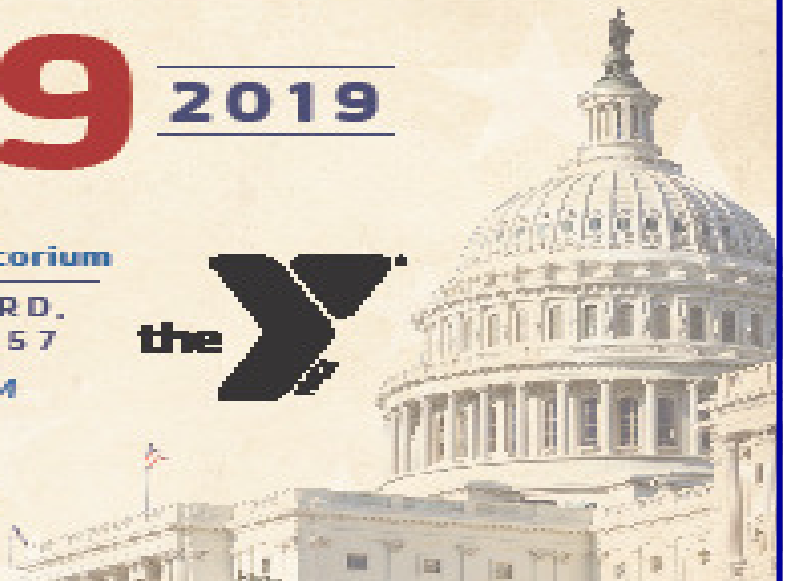
